Encasing Fabric Care Instructions



For Pillow Encasings: Close the zipper and machine wash the encasing every 10 to 14 days in HOT water (or consider using a special laundry product for allergy sufferers). Tumble dry at the LOWEST setting. Do not bleach, iron or dry clean.

For Mattress and Comforter Encasings: Vacuum the entire surface of the encasing every 10 to 14 days to capture any allergens that may have gotten on the surface. For best results, consider using an allergy-proof vacuum or vacuum bag. Close the zipper and machine wash the encasing once or twice a year in HOT water (or consider using a special laundry product for allergy sufferers). Tumble dry at the LOWEST setting. Do not bleach, iron or dry clean.



For Pillow Encasings: Close the zipper and machine wash the encasing every 10 to 14 days in HOT water (or consider using a special laundry product for allergy sufferers). Tumble dry at the LOWEST setting. Do not bleach, iron or dry clean.

For Mattress Encasings: Vacuum the entire surface of the encasing every 10 to 14 days to capture any allergens that may have gotten on the surface. For best results, consider using an allergy-proof vacuum or vacuum bag. Close the zipper and machine wash the encasing once or twice a year in HOT water (or consider using a special laundry product for allergy sufferers). Tumble dry at the LOWEST setting. Do not bleach, iron or dry clean.

For Pillow Encasings: Close the zipper and machine wash the encasing every 10 to 14 days in HOT water (or consider using a special laundry product for allergy sufferers). Tumble dry at the LOWEST setting. Do not bleach, iron or dry clean.

For Mattress and Comforter Encasings: Vacuum the entire surface of the encasing every 10 to 14 days to capture any allergens that may have gotten on the surface. For best results, consider using an allergy-proof vacuum or vacuum bag. Close the zipper and machine wash the encasing once or twice a year in HOT water (or consider using a special laundry product for allergy sufferers). Tumble dry at the LOWEST setting. Do not bleach, iron or dry clean.



For Pillow & Mattress Encasings: Surface may be vacuumed monthly to remove allergen and dust that may have settled out of the air or you may lightly spray the encasing with an anti-allergen product. For best results, consider using an allergy-proof vacuum or vacuum bag. Wash only if necessary. Close the zipper and machine wash separately in HOT water with mild detergent. Or instead of hot water, consider using a special laundry product for allergy sufferers. Tumble dry at the LOWEST setting. Do not bleach, iron or dry clean.

Encasing Fabric Care Instructions Con't



For Pillow Encasings: Close the zipper and machine wash the encasing every 10 to 14 days in HOT water (or consider using a special laundry product for allergy sufferers). Tumble dry at the LOWEST setting. Do not bleach, iron or dry clean. Using bleach or drying at high temperatures will diminish the water-resistant properties of this encasing and cause the Comfortech polyurethane membrane to separate from the outer fabric.

For Mattress Encasings: Vacuum the entire surface of the encasing every 10 to 14 days to capture any allergens that may have gotten on the surface. For best results, consider using an allergy-proof vacuum or vacuum bag. Close the zipper and machine wash the encasing once or twice a year in HOT water (or consider using a special laundry product for allergy sufferers). Tumble dry at the LOWEST setting. Do not bleach, iron or dry clean. Using bleach or drying at high temperatures will diminish the water-resistant properties of this encasing and cause the Comfortech polyurethane membrane to separate from the outer fabric.



For Inner Liner Encasings: Vacuum the entire surface of the encasing every 10 to 14 days to capture any allergens that may have gotten on the surface. For best results, consider using an allergy-proof vacuum or vacuum bag. Hand wash ONLY in emergencies using a mild detergent and warm water. Air dry using no heat. Do not bleach, iron or dry clean.
